#### ANGEL

(2007, M) France, Belgium, UK. Romance, Drama.

Angel Deverell comes of age in

Edwardian Cheshire knowing she will
be a great writer. Rising above her class
(her widowed mother has a grocery
shop), Angel finds a publisher and a
wide audience for her frothy romances.
With royalties, she buys an estate, then
she's smitten by Esme, a rake from
local aristocracy and an artist of dark
temperament. She hires Esme's sister
Nora, who dotes on her, as a personal
assistant, and pursues Esme.

Angel is grandly self-centred, colouring her world as if it were one of her novels. When the Great War breaks out and reality begins to trump her will, can Angel hold on to her man and her public?

Inspired by the life of Marie Corelli. An all-star cast: Romola Garai, Sam Neill, Charlotte Rampling and Michael Fassbender. Eaglehawk Film Festival is an annual film festival with a difference - each year curated around a unique theme. 2024 is Angelic!

What is an angel? Dictionary definitions range from a spiritual being, a guardian spirit, a person who is kind, pure, or beautiful, to a term of endearment or even simply a name or nickname. In the world of film, all of these are explored in a variety of ways. A versatile term which in its many forms has been called upon time and again since the early days of cinema.

(1937, G) USA. Comedy, Romance. Dir: Ernst Lubitsch

A woman and her husband take separate vacations, and she falls in love with another man. The last film for Marlene Dietrich at Paramount, this is a wonderful romantic comedy.



#### ANGEL

(1983, R18+) USA. Action, Crime.
Dir: Robert Vincent O'Neil
15-year-old Molly is the best in her class in high school. Nobody suspects that the model pupil earns her money at night as prostitute "Angel" on Sunset Blvd.
A 1980's cult classic.



# ANGEL BABY

**(1961, UN15+)** USA. Drama.

Dirs: Paul Wendskos & Hubert Cornfield In his film debut, Burt Reynolds vies with George Hamilton for the love of one heavenly woman. In the American South, evangelist Paul Strand (Hamilton) meets a beautiful young mute named Jenny, affectionately known as Angel Baby.



## ANGEL (MON ANGE)

(2016, UN15+) Belgium. Drama, Romance. Dir: Harry Cleven Devastated with grief after the mysterious disappearance of her magician lover, Louise is sent to a psychiatric asylum. Nine months later, she gives birth to Angel, a baby boy with an incredible gift: he is invisible.



#### ANGEL

(1982, M) Ireland, UK. *Drama*, *Music*. Dir: Neil Jordan

Saxophonist Danny witnesses the murder of his band manager and a deaf-mute girl after a gig. Questioned by the police, he remembers only the orthopaedic shoes of the killers' leader. Starring Oscar-nominated Stephen Rea.



# ANGEL (UN ANGE)

(2018, UN15+) Belgium, Netherlands, Senegal. *Drama, Romance*. Dir: Koen Mortier Follows the encounter of a prostitute, Fae, and a world-famous athlete, Thierry. It is a film based on true people and true facts; especially cyclist Frank Vandenbroucke.
